Jason:

You'll recall that I mentioned during our conference call on Monday morning that the Society knows of a restoration project at **95 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue South**, situated between major community historic landmarks (Historic Palm Cottage and the Naples Pier). The owner is still working with his team to prepare plans for your review.

In addition to that property, I have just learned about two other properties that sit majestically in the Naples Historic District and will undergo restoration as well. Like the house above, both of these residential buildings are recognized by SHPO and the National Register as historic contributing properties; the addresses are: **66 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue South** and **92 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue South**. Jon Kukk, Kukk Architecture & Design, PA, is the architect of record for these two properties; you've worked with him in the past.

Since Naples does not have a sanctioned historic preservation program yet, these restoration plans will also come to you for review; I mentioned to Jon today that you/SHPO Compliance will turn reviews around in 30 days, per our Monday conversation. Jon and his client will move forward sooner rather than later. This is a heads up.

We are deeply grateful to the owners of these historic houses because they are choosing to retain the historic character of their houses, and that adds tremendous value to the integrity of the Naples Historic District. And, they are doing this with their own resources!

I look forward to hearing from you with regard to the City of Naples being able to move forward with its preservation program.
